AMENDMENT 2

Clarifying questions have been posed by an interested vendor, and per the RFP, the answers are being provided to all interested vendors:

Question: Objectives (Technical Requirements), item g. Please clarify what is meant by ” ... supports real-time sketch and change detection, without a third-party requirement.”

Answer: The CAMA software must include the necessary sketch tools for staff to use. When sketch creation/modifications are complete and saved the changes will be reflected in real time to the CAMA platform and public facing site.

Question: Objectives (Technical Requirements), item m. Please clarify what is meant by ”...provide real-time GIS system layer that allow appraisal staff to value properties as CAMA changes are being made.”.

Answer: When GIS staff modify layers, the changes are able to reflect live within the system ensuring as up to date and accurate information.

Question: Objectives (Technical Requirements), item n. On most data conversion projects, it’s typical to convert all years for data such as owner, values, notes, and sales history, but only converting 3 years of data such as land, buildings, and sketch history. Is this acceptable to the County?

Answer: No

Question: Objectives (Technical Requirements), item o. i. Please clarify what is meant by “...nightly extracts to county’s server”. What data from the cloud is being extracted to the county’s servers?

Answer: There are currently vendors who rely on specific sets of data that are provided by nightly extracts. Some of these will be addressed by requirements of the new CAMA solution; however for those that would not we want to continue to work with these agencies by providing limited data. The full specifics of the data can be addressed at a later point, but examples include transfer history, tax ownership, land values.

Question: Objectives (Technical Requirements), item o. ii. Please clarify what is meant by “...current third-party integrations”. Are you referring to cloud-hosting the data that is produced by the third-party application(s), or actually cloud-hosting the third-party application(s) along with the data that is produced by the third-party?

Answer: The new platform should include the housing of necessary data produced by any of our current 3rd party applications that will be integrated into the platform. There is no requirement to host 3rd party applications in the cloud.

Question: General. Please provide an estimate for the number of concurrent users between the Auditor and Treasurer's office.

Answer: 40 users
