**MS. FRENCHKO MADE A MOTION TO MODIFY THIS ITEM TO REFLECT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS STRIKES THE INTERNAL APPLICANT HIRING POLICY LANGUAGE ON PG. 59 OF THE COUNTY'S POLICY MANUAL WHICH PREVENTS POSTING OF ALLOWABLE UNION JOBS AND STATES AND THE FINAL SENTENCE: POSITIONS THAT HAVE CURRENTLY PERSONNEL READY TO ASSUME THAT POSITION WILL NOT BE POSTED."**

NOTE: This will prevent the county Commissioners and their HR Staff from passing jobs off based on favoritism or other reasons besides qualifications. Mr. Cantalamessa called, Point of Order. Mr. Fuda told Ms. Frenchko she keeps accusing people of things and these are things she is doing. Ms. Frenchko said that was an automatic Second—Discussion is an automatic second.

**MR. GARY NEWBROUGH REQUESTED TO MODIFY THE AGENDA ITEM TO CHANGE THE EFFECTIVE DATE FROM JUNE 20, 2022 TO JUNE 21, 2022.**

Ms. Frenchko called Point of Order stating the Commissioners have to make the Motion to Modify, and not from someone in the Audience.

Commissioner Cantalamessa made a Motion to approve the Amended date to June 21, 2022. Mr. Fuda seconded the Motion.

*Ms. Frenchko said she had questions related to this position from the Human Resources Department/. She stated this position will pay \$90,000.00/yr, (\$120,000.00 salary package), and she had more questions relating to design, and full-time need. She said she doesn't believe it is the correct thing to do as Mr. Newbrough wants to increase rates to pay for restructuring. She spoke about going out for Bid for design services and said this came to her without any information and without Mr. Newbrough attending her meeting. She said there was no job description for the position. She had concerns for this consultant having a private interest in an Agenda Item that recently came in. She inquired about an ethics check, and said if one was done, she wanted a copy. Mr. Fuda asked Mr. Newbrough to explain. Gary Newbrough said he thought Bob Mariano sent in all of the back-up documentation. Mr. Fuda and Ms. Frenchko spoke about having written minutes for Mr. Fuda and Mr. Cantalamessa's agenda meetings. Mr. Newbrough said the main reason for bringing Mr. Makosky in was for bid packages and specifications and went on to speak of the money that would be saved by the County for doing the process in house. Mr. Newbrough said Mr. Makosky's contract ends with the project before his start date. Ms. Frenchko brought up the State Rd. Phase II Project, asked for an ethics check and to Table this item. Mr. Newbrough stated he was confident that was not needed. Mr. Cantalamessa said he didn't understand why one Commissioner was standing in the way of \$150,000.00 worth of savings to the Sanitary Engineer's Department and asked her to explain. Ms. Frenchko spoke of inconsistent processes. Ms. Frenchko called Point of Order stating she was being interrupted and said the process has been inconsistent since she started. She spoke about HR issues and the county policy. Mr. Fuda said she is accusing and assuming, and that Gary is an expert with 90 million dollars' worth of projects and she doesn't go to any of the departments to learn the job. Ms. Frenchko spoke about policies and flow charts.*

*Mr. Fuda stated Ms. Frenchko was delaying the work of the of the Clerks by not signing their work in a timely manner. He said she is having the secretary gather the documents in a folder, bring them to her office where they have not been returned the same day. Ms. Frenchko said the items are being taken off the table on the weekends and there have been contract pages left for signing without the contract attached and she wants to know what she is signing. Mr. Cantalamessa said she has already voted on these items that she needs to sign. Mr. Fuda said the clerks need their work signed as she accuses them of not doing work in a timely manner. Ms. Frenchko said she spent the day in Ashtabula and saw how they get their documents signed. Mr. Fuda said that Ms. Frenchko was lying about the Clerks taking the documents off the signing table on the weekends.*

She went on to tell Ms. Frenchko that it was inappropriate to talk about private matters that should have been discussed in Executive Session and her dropping F bombs. She asked the Board what they are doing in regards to locating a new building for the Dog Kennel.*

*Mr. Cantalamessa said there are new board members that will be more receptive to Trumbull County's needs as it wasn't financially feasible in the past. Ms. Hebert addressed Ms. Frenchko for making negative remarks and said her taxes pay Ms. Frenchko's salary. Ms. Frenchko called Point of Order stating Ms. Hebert doesn't get to attack. Ms. Frenchko said, it's going to be a rude awakening next year. Mr. Fuda said Ms. Frenchko was threatening her job, Mr. Newbrough's job and it's on record. Ms. Hebert spoke about the kill rate compared to the past. Ms. Frenchko left the meeting at 11:39 a.m. and returned shortly thereafter. Mr. Dennis Kutchna had questions about the Blueprint to Prosperity Project. Mr. Fuda told Mr. Kutchna to call Gary Newbrough and he would help him. Mr. Tom Klejka, Superintendent of the Highway Dept. addressed Mr. Fuda regarding comments Mr. Fuda made during the June 1, 2022 regular meeting. Mr. Klejka addressed the four problems that Mr. Fuda spoke about and said that only one of the four was related to the highway department and they didn't have any knowledge of the problem prior to hearing it at the meeting. Mr. Fuda said for years he has worked with the Highway Department and they worked as a team. He said he would have never have read those issues off but he was showing Ms. Frenchko how much time it would take to read everything he receives. Mr. Klejka said Mr. Fuda owes the men and woman of the Highway Dept. an apology for insinuating they were not doing their job. Mr. Fuda apologized if he made it sound like the Highway Department was not doing their job. Mr. Gerberry said that he feels cut off by Mr. Fuda when he has presented his items--he often feels short-changed. He said he and Mr. Papalas told Mr. Fuda the Highway Engineer's Office would only be attending one meeting. Ms. Frenchko brought up a memo that was sent out and that she disagrees with it and would like a Prosecutor's opinion. Mayor Kyle spoke about sanitary sewer and septic and long-term solutions. He said he wanted to get his people clean water and wanted to work together so his community could receive reliable utilities.*

*Ms. Frenchko commented on a statement made by Mr. Fuda regarding the Kinsman Project when he said it was important, but not politically. She said it suggests a lot of projects are prioritized politically. Mr. Fuda wanted to explain and stated when he started the Kinsman Project, it was said to be impossible to accomplish. Mr. Fuda said he and Mr. Heltzel made changes where they fought with the USDA and EPA regarding Kinsman. He said he was approached by someone who asked why he would fight for such a small community. He spoke about Braceville Township and small communities, stating the 80 million worth of projects were not done in large communities.*
