Q: "For a newly operating transportation provider that does not have two years of operating history what documentation will TCDJFS accept to demonstrate its ability to meet the program requirements in light of Section XII (C), which states that the two-year viability request is not intended to eliminate potential providers that can otherwise meet the program requirements"

A: For a business that has not been viable at the location of service provision within the Trumbull County vicinity for a minimum of two (2) years prior to the date a response to this RFB is submitted, and also does not have established service provision outside of the Trumbull County vicinity, it is the responsibility of the potential service provider to determine any statements, records of services provided, and/or financial documentation that would verify that the business conducts regular services and is independently viable outside of services that would be provided under any resulting Contract from this RFB.

A: For a business that is newly operating and did not conduct business during the requested 2024 and 2025 tax years and therefore has no business federal income tax filings for those years, the bidder may submit a statement indicating the initial date of business which will be reviewed in conjunction with the business filing with the Ohio Secretary of State. The bidder must also submit sufficient documentation of financial capacity that it conducts regular business services and is independently viable outside of services that would be provided under any resulting Contract from this RFB.
