

**Trumbull County
Notice of CHIP Public Hearing**

Date of Publication: May 18, 2024

Trumbull County intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development, Office of Community Development for funding under the Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Program. CHIP is a federally funded program administered by the state. The county is eligible for \$250,000 of Fiscal Year 2026 CDBG funding, provided the county meets applicable program requirements. On Tuesday, March 3, 2026, the County conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements.

Based on program guidelines released on February 12, 2026, the county is eligible to undertake the following CHIP activities for Fiscal Year 2026:

Eligible Activities

- 1. Private Owner Home Rehabilitation**
- 2. Rental Home Rehabilitation**
- 3. Private Owner Home Repair**
- 4. Rental Home Repair**
- 5. Administration**
- 6. Fair Housing**

A second public hearing will be held Wednesday, May 27, 2026, at 6:00 pm at the Weathersfield Fire Station, located at 2229 Gardenland Avenue, Niles, Ohio 44446 to give citizens an adequate opportunity to review and comment on the county's proposed CHIP application, including proposed activities summarized above, before the county submits its application to the Ohio Development Services Agency.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this meeting on Wednesday, May 27, 2026, to express their views and comments on the county's proposed CHIP application.
