The Trumbull County Planning Commission shall consist of eleven (11) members, three (3) of whom will be the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners and eight (8) citizens of the County, appointed by the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners. *One (1) of the appointees shall be a resident of a limited home rule township in the county, selected at the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners, from persons recommended by the limited home rule township. One (1) appointee shall be a resident of the municipal corporation with the largest population contained within the portion of the municipal corporation located in the county, selected at the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners from persons recommended by that municipal corporation. The remaining six (6) appointees shall be residents of the county, selected at the discretion of the Board of Trumbull County Commissioners. The terms for the eight (8) citizen members shall be for three years. This is in accordance with Section 713.22 (B)(2) of the *Ohio Revised Code*.
