Warren man given indefinite prison sentence



John L. Daniel Jr., 52, at left, of Berkshire Drive, Warren, was given an indefinite prison sentence of 117 months to 153 months after a Trumbull County jury found him guilty Tuesday, February 6, 2024, of a second-degree felonious assault felony with a firearm specification and a third-degree domestic violence charge.

The jurors, who deliberated a little less than two hours, also came back with a not guilty verdict on a third-degree having weapons while under disability felony charge.

Common Pleas Judge Ronald J. Rice said the seriousness of the offenses and the violent criminal history of the defendant required the need for consecutive sentences. The sentence also included a mandatory three-year term because a gun was used in the commission of the crime.

State's evidence in the two-day trial showed that Daniel was involved in a shooting June 25, 2023, at the Berkshire Drive residence.

Testimony showed the male victim was shot at least five times in the side and the leg. The victim was in court for the sentencing but did not speak. He had submitted a written victim impact statement.

Handling the prosecution was First Assistant Prosecutor Christopher Becker, who was pleased with the sentence.

"Apparently, his modus operandi is that he hits women and household members," Becker said noting it was Daniel's third domestic violence conviction.

This case is one of several domestic violence cases this office has successfully prosecuted in the last few months, including the guilty verdict by a jury in the trial of Joseph Lowe Jr., 42, who was convicted and sentenced to 36 months in prison for domestic violence and violating a protection order in a violent incident against his family last year. Other domestic violence cases successfully prosecuted by this office include:

- David Hubbard, 40, of North Road NE, Warren, was sentenced to 24 months in state prison after he admitted to violating his probation for a August 2022 conviction for third degree domestic violence and third-degree violating a protection order. Hubbard also faces new charges of strangulation and domestic violence before Judge Ronald Rice in Common Pleas Court.
- Quin'daz Stubbs, 27, of Hamilton Street SW, Warren, pleaded guilty to a third-degree domestic violence charge and was sentenced to 24 months in prison. Stubbs was charged with a felony because of three previous domestics and assault charges within the last three years in Warren Municipal Court. The case involved a Oct. 1, 2023, incident at a Union Street SW home where a 22-year-old woman was beaten and choked.
