## Reward offered for man wanted in beating of child

The United States Marshal Service has made the 26-year-old man involved in the beating of an 18-month-old child and his mother in Warren last week as the agency's Fugitive of the Week.

Tyrell Williams, 26, is wanted by the marshals, the Ohio Adult Parole Authority and the Warren Police Department on child endangering and domestic violence charges. The incident took place July 11 at a home on West Market Street in Warren Township.
