Dear Attorney Hoying:

As the long-time elected Prosecuting Attorney for Trumbull County who established the Child Assault Prosecution Unit back in 1986, as one of the first such

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units in the country from our county obtaining a federal grant, it has been our journey to serve the public by working closely with the local children services agency, police, hospitals, and citizens to effectively prosecute child sex offenders. We are recognizing, this year, the people involved in this team effort to make our community safer for forty years. This effort also includes working with the courts and the parole board in providing information, which will ensure that justice will be carried out in the future.

There have been four division heads of my Child Assault Division since its inception. Currently, Chief of that Division is Gabe Wildman. Because Felicia Banks Beemer is one of the worst child sexual predators this office has ever prosecuted, Attorney Wildman is joining me in a joint letter to the Parole Board strongly opposing inmate Beemer's release on parole now or in the future. Retired Chief, Diane Barber, handled this prosecution under my direction. Additionally, we write you to also urge the Board to not only deny parole to this inmate, but also to ask the Board to not reschedule her for another hearing for ten years, the maximum period of time provided by law.

It is our intent to fully review the facts in this matter and the resultant convictions and sentences of Felicia Banks Beemer and include with our letter a package of relevant matters for your further review. We firmly believe that with a fair review of everything regarding inmate Beemer (and her cohort husband, Cody Banks, who are two of a kind) that this case supports our view that prisons protect society from the malevolent like her and that Beemer's horrifying actions explains why democratic societies need life imprisonment or even the death penalty as a punishment, which was an option when this great country was founded. As Ohio law states today: "The overriding purposes of felony sentencing are to protect the public from future crimes by the offender and others, to punish the offender, and to promote the effective rehabilitation of the offender ..." See Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.11(A). When looking at the whole picture; (1) the Beemer life

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sentence protects the public from future crime; (2) it correctly punishes her, and (3) her rehabilitative efforts are meaningless.

Now to the facts of this case, as you are aware, on October 29, 2012, Felicia Banks Beemer pleaded guilty to an amended indictment charging her with Counts 1, 2: Rape (Life), in violation of R.C. 2907.02(A)(1)(b); Counts 3 & 4: Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor (F2), in violation of R.C. 2907.322(A)(1); Count 5: Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor (F4), in violation of R.C. 2907.322(A)(5); Count 6: Pandering Obscenity Involving a Minor (F2), in violation of R.C. 2907.321(A)(1); and Count 7: Pandering Obscenity Involving a Minor (F4), in violation of R.C. 2907.321(A)(5). That same date, Felicia Banks Beemer was sentenced to an aggregate prison term of LIFE in prison, with parole eligibility after serving fifteen (15) full years.

The underlying sexual conduct that gave rise to these charges is unconscionable and horrific. An investigation by the Warren Police Department in Trumbull County, Ohio discovered that this Defendant and her sex offender husband, Cody Banks, recorded themselves sexually assaulting, molesting, and raping two separate child victims, both under the age of two years old, on separate occasions.

In the first instance, Felicia Beemer and her husband, Cody Banks, took turns sexually assaulting minor male victim, D.A. dob 12/21/2009, while babysitting him for a family friend. During that first incident, Cody Banks sexually molested and masturbated 1 year old D.A.'s penis while Felicia Beemer cheered him on and watched with glee. Beemer then took her turn and performed oral sex on the toddler. To add insult to these horrific and shocking crimes, Cody Banks videotaped the entirety of this encounter, preserving the rape and degradation of this poor toddler for posterity. It is evident from the video of these sex acts that Beemer was a willing and eager participant to these crimes.

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In a separate incident, mere weeks after the grotesque sexual assault of minor male victim D.A., dob 12/21/2009, Banks and Beemer attended a supervised visitation for their then 8-month-old biological daughter, J.B., dob 8/18/2010, at Trumbull County Children's Services, located in Warren, Ohio. Specifically, they were scheduled for a supervised visit with their daughter in the Trumbull County Children's Services Board facility. While in the nursery of that facility, after the case-worker had left them alone with their baby, Banks and Beemer again decided to violate and sexually abuse an innocent, defenseless child. Much like the incident involving minor male victim D.A., Cody Banks sexually assaulted his own daughter, inserting his fingers inside her vagina while Felicia Beemer watched and cheered him on. After Banks finished raping 8-month-old J.B., Beemer performed oral sex on the child, admittedly inserting her tongue into the 8-month-old's vaginal cavity. True to his very nature, Cody Banks recorded and videotaped this entire encounter. Like the first incident, Beemer was a willing and eager participant in these atrocities, patiently waiting to take her turn.

This sick and twisted Bonnie and Clyde duo were ultimately found out when a relative saw the videos on one of their electronic devices and turned the SIM card over to law enforcement. Consequently, the evidence in this case was overwhelming as to both Cody Banks and Felicia Beemer. The evidence unequivocally illustrates that Felicia Beemer is a predator, child pornographer, pedophile, and a child rapist. She preyed on multiple children who trusted her. She preyed on an infant and a toddler. She even had recorded sex with a dog. She ensured that her crimes were captured on video so that her co-defendant and her could revisit, lust, and revictimize these children at their leisure.

We wish we could write this letter and indicate to this Board that Inmate Beemer showed some remorse and made efforts to turn her life around while in prison. Unfortunately, one cannot look at her record while incarcerated and come to any other conclusion than that she is an unrepentant, deranged individual prone to violence, who is clearly still dangerous and will remain a danger for the rest of her life. In fact, evidence shows her violent sexual mania continues from home to prison.

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Her prison disciplinary record is the worst Prosecutor Watkins has seen since taking office in 1984. She has been incarcerated in Ohio's prison system for approximately the past 14 years, and Inmate Beemer has amassed a staggering 85 documented disciplinary infractions. A deeper dive into these records clearly illustrates that Felicia Beemer remains a violent sexual predator, who refuses to follow even the simplest of rules. It is not difficult to imagine the havoc she would undoubtedly wreak if she were to be turned loose, especially when knowing that she is clear and present danger to others in prison!

These documented disciplinary infractions range from the more mundane, such as not following orders or being in a prohibited area, to more serious incidents as will be outlined below. Due to the severity and frequency of these infractions, it is necessary to categorize them to effectively draw attention to Felicia Beemer's continued threat to humanity.

I. THE PREDATORY ASSAULT OF JANUARY 27, 2025: SEXUAL DEPREDATION BEHIND BARS

The most glaring, alarm-sounding proof of Beemer's dangerousness is her continuation of predatory sexual assault while housed in a state correctional facility. On **January 27, 2025**, while enrolled in a specialized treatment program at the Ohio Reformatory for Women (ORW)—a program designed to afford her a path to behavioral management— Beemer chose instead to sexually victimize another incarcerated woman. As detailed in the official ODRC Rule Infraction Summary dated **February 6, 2025** (Rule 3.2 Violation: *Non-consensual sexual contact*):

"On 02/06/25, Ohio Reformatory for Women Incarcerated Person Amanda Daniels W112433; verbally reported to a non-security first responder, that she was the victim during an incident where alleged 'Sexual Contact' occurred. I/P Daniels alleges that in the afternoon on 01/27/25, during a program activity inside of the Ohio

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Reformatory for Women Arn-2 tapestry unit; ORW I/P Felicia Beemer W85115 without warning or provocation, intentionally 'grabbed/rubbed her inner thigh' from underneath the table on the outer garment of her clothing, while the two were seated next to each other in the unit."

— ODRC Disciplinary Summary, RIB Disposition Date 02/06/2025 (Rule 3.2)

When confronted by institutional investigators, Beemer demonstrated the quintessential dishonesty and cold calculation of a practiced predator: she initially lied and outright denied her misconduct, only to later confess when confronted with overwhelming evidence captured on institutional video (ORW-ARN2-VID2). The institutional investigating official reached an unwavering, alarming conclusion regarding Beemer's predatory nature:

"It is the determination of this investigatory official, that I/P Beemer has a difficult time keeping her hands to herself.. It is also the determination of this investigatory official that this act was 'sexual in nature' with intent as also the victim perceiving the act to be sexual in nature. I believe separation must occur with I/P Beemer returning to the Dayton Correctional Institutional, so there can be no more potential victims at ORW for I/P Beemer to continue to engage in predatory behavior."

— ODRC Disciplinary Summary, RIB Disposition Date 02/06/2025 (Rule 3.2) (emphasis added).

Let this sink in: an inmate serving a life sentence for raping multiple children, specifically an infant and a toddler, was actively engaging in non-consensual, predatory sexual assault inside a state facility as recently as 2025. She clearly cannot resist the urge to violate others. To release such an uninhibited sexual

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predator into the public sphere would be nothing short of state-sanctioned negligence and a catastrophic failure of public safety. Indeed, this incident alone should forever disqualify Felicia Beemer from ever being released. Unfortunately for Beemer, there are dozens more reasons to keep her behind bars.

II. A RAMPAGING HISTORY OF VIOLENCE, ASSAULTS, AND THREATS (14 SEPARATE, DOCUMENTED INCIDENTS)

Beemer's institutional record is a relentless catalog of bloodshed, unprovoked physical attacks, and terrorization of those around her. A deep dive into her 85 disciplinary write-ups reveals a chronic, habitual pattern of physical fighting, battery, hit-for-hire assaults, explicit death threats, and racially motivated threats targeting both vulnerable inmates and correctional staff. At least **14 separate incidents** highlight her uncontrollable violent temper:

- **July 16, 2024 (Rule 1.5):** Officer Pezo observed Beemer in a rage, throwing books and creating chaos after claiming another inmate called her names.
- **May 5, 2023 (Rule 08 - Threats to Staff):** Lieutenant Shonk reported that Beemer confronted him, stating she was unhappy with her unit officer and threatened: *"because of how much time she has done she would not be afraid to do something to this Officer."* When asked if she intended harm, Beemer chillingly declared, *"I am not thinking about it, I'm going to,"* and continued spouting violent threats while escorted to the Temporary Protection Unit (TPU).
- **February 24, 2023 (Rule 04 - Violent Assault):** C/O Muhammad witnessed Beemer violently *"run up behind inmate Stewart 105294 and shove her to the ground. Them [sic] inmate Beemer preceded to get on top of Stewart,"* requiring the threat of chemical agents (OC spray) to halt her vicious assault.

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- **May 28, 2022 (Rules 08 & 26 - Threats & Hate Speech):** While being escorted to her cell, Beemer violently threatened her cellmate, screaming "*Bitch, I will kick your ass*" and hurling vile racial slurs, "*Fuck you, nigger.*"
- **May 17, 2022 (Rule 19 - Unprovoked Battery):** Officer R. Smith discovered Beemer cornering and "*punching Inmate Edwards (107306) in the back and shoulder area with closed fists. Edwards had her face to the door trying to cover up screaming 'Get her off me!'*" Beemer admitted the savage beating was simply because she "*did not like the comments Edwards made towards her.*"
- **February 8, 2022 (Rule 04 - Closed-Fist Strike):** Inmate Melton reported—and Beemer confessed—that Beemer struck her cellmate in the forehead with a closed-fist during institutional count.
- **August 22, 2020 (Rule 19 - Physical Violence):** Officers observed Beemer aggressively shoving Inmate Stewart in the chest with such force that Stewart crashed to the ground, holding her hands up in fear, attempting to shield her face from further blows.
- **February 25, 2020 (Rule 19 – Physical Altercation):** Officer Papi caught Beemer engaged in a physical altercation with Inmate Doty on the housing unit range.
- **September 19, 2019 (Rules 21 & 26 - Violent Outburst):** Beemer engaged in a screaming match, hurling obscenities, ignoring direct orders, and violently punching prison walls in uncontrolled rage.
- **February 17, 2017 (Rule 19 - Ambush Battery):** Officer Gaddis witnessed Beemer stalking Inmate Rearick from behind over a personal dispute, running up and striking Rearick with her fist in an unprovoked ambush.
- **August 13, 2015 (Rule 19 - Physical Altercation):** Beemer admitted to

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engaging in a violent physical fight with her cellmate Harris, striking her.

- **May 19, 2015 (Rule 08 - Threat of Harm):** Beemer threatened Officer Pratt that *"if I did not place her in cuffs, she was going to hurt her cell mate - Inmate Cathey 87411."*
- **April 14, 2015 (Rule 19 - Bloody Dishroom Fight):** Beemer emerged from the institutional dishroom with red marks on her face, leaving fellow inmate Maynard inside with *"blood expelling from her mouth"* following a violent melee.
- **August 15, 2014 (Rules 04, 45, & 35 - Hit-for-Hire Assault on Sleeping Inmate):** Sgt. Morales investigated an atrocious incident where Beemer snuck into Cell 135 while Inmate Motter was asleep and struck her in the head with a closed fist. Beemer confessed she carried out the violent hit because another inmate promised to *"pay her well, and take care of her while she was in Segregation."*

III. TOTAL DEFIANCE OF REHABILITATION AND INSTITUTIONAL ORDER AND SUFFERS FROM A CHARACTER DISORDER SHOWING THAT INMATE IS BEYOND HELP AND A PENAL TOLL TO SOCIETY.

In addition to her explosive violence and sexual offenses, Beemer's record of 85 write-ups reveals a complete, documented and total disdain for institutional authority.

Though because of editing by the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction in its Current Institutional Report Summary dated July 20, 2026 the Trumbull County Prosecutor's Office does not know Inmate Beemer's Current Risk Score and Current Sex Offender Classification (which may be unchartable!), as well as many rehabilitative program records which been blacked out, it is still discernable

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from the remaining records, especially Beemer's massive Disciplinary History, including her Rule Infraction Board records, that her remarkable constant bad behavior behind bars clearly and consistently supports our view of her that the nature of her convictions proves that uniquely Beemer at her relatively young age is a continuing clear and present danger to children and people everywhere including inmates and prison staff. She is a Poster-Person for life imprisonment and solitary confinement!

The institutional records reflect that she repeatedly diverts and "cheeks" controlled medications (3/23/2023, 3/19/2023), fakes medical seizures to manipulate staff (12/28/2022), routinely refuses mandatory medical/pill calls, extorts and trades illicit and stolen property, and disrespects prison staff, telling correctional officers to "*Suck my dick*" (7/27/2023) and "*Fuck you bitch motherfucker*" (5/25/2013).

Beemer has proven over 14 long years that she is utterly incorrigible, profoundly aggressive, and biologically incapable of existing in society without inflicting devastating harm on others. She was given access to rehabilitative programs, including the Tapestry unit, only to use that opportunity to sexually assault a fellow participant. Learning is not on her agenda.

IV IQ AND MENTAL AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH HISTORY

It is also important for the Board to know that two of three forensic experts who evaluated inmate Beemer once she filed motions in Court alleging that she was both incompetent and insane to stand trial found her both competent and sane. Furthermore, they concluded she was not mentally retarded, she knew right from wrong, and suffered from alcohol and cannabis abuse. Though Beemer's own expert said she was mildly retarded, he also found that she knew right from wrong when filming and raping her own infant child and toddler relative. It is further

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mentioned that the prosecution in this case recommended a life sentence with a full 15 years served before parole eligibility at sentencing which was in part based on her claim that her older husband unduly influenced her in committing the sex offenses. We may be wrong here because, once away from Cody, nothing has changed in her continuing bad behavior and criminal conduct. She still commits vicious acts and sex offenses against others while in prison! Without her husband by her side Beemer is a very independent and self-directed Evil Doer and rehabilitation is not in her vocabulary.

As retired Trumbull County Court of Common Pleas Judge W. Wyatt McKay in his Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law on Competency to Stand Trial regarding Beemer states in relevant part that:

The Defendant is motivated by a favorable outcome and wants to serve as little time as possible. While the Defendant has less of an attention span than others, the Court finds that it is sufficient if the Court gives frequent breaks during trial.

Additionally, the Court finds that the Defendant's recall of the events gives her the capacity to challenge prosecution witnesses through her attorney at trial. While, she is diagnosed with depression and attention deficit, she does not have a mental illness that would defeat competency to stand trial. Dr. Fabain also diagnosed the Defendant as having mild mental retardation that in his opinion renders her unable to adequately assist her attorney in her defense. This Court specifically rejects this argument and agrees with Dr. Resnick and Dr. Gazley that while the Defendant is borderline in intellectual functioning, she is able to adequately assist her attorney due in part to her ability to understand questions, and respond in a relevant manner

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and her capacity to provide relevant information to her attorney as well as being able to follow his advice and instruction.

... By a preponderance of the evidence, the Court finds the Defendant competent to stand trial (as the Parole Board knows the Defendant Beemer with advice of counsel chose to plead guilty and waived her constitutional rights including the right to have a jury trial to determine her guilt).

State's Exhibit #19 (Attached) – Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law – Judge W. Wyatt McKay – 2 pages.

Further, regarding Beemer's responsibility for committing the crime charged and despite her claim she was "drinking heavily and using marijuana on a daily basis" Dr. Thomas Gazley, Court Psychologist concluded with reasonable psychological certainty that Beemer did not suffer a severe mental disease or defect and at the time of the offenses charged, knew the wrongfulness of her acts.

Lastly, renowned and nationally recognized forensic psychiatrist Dr. Phillip J. Resnick M.D. was the prosecution's appointed expert who evaluated Beemer in 2012 and also wrote reports regarding Beemer's competency and sanity. He noted that Beemer scored 76 and 71 on intelligence testing and she has reported a history of sex abuse as a child. Dr. Resnick Diagnostic Impression included: 1. Major Depressive Episode, now in partial remission; 2. Post traumatic Stress Disorder by history; 3. Attention Deficit Disorder; 4. Alcohol abuse; 5. Cannabis abuse; and 6. Borderline Intellectual Functioning. After reviewing all records and reports in this case Dr. Resnick wrote: "It is my opinion with reasonable medical certainty that Mrs. Beemer was not suffering from a severe mental disease or defect at the time of the acts with which she is accused ... Mrs. Beemer's psychological testing and

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adaptive functioning place her in the borderline intellectual functioning ranges ... It is my opinion with reasonable medical certainty that even if Mrs. Beemer's intellectual abilities were considered to be a severe mental defect, her mental defect did not cause her not to know the wrongfulness of her sexual acts ...

Further, please find enclosed a packet of information and exhibits with respect to this case which includes the original indictment, summary police reports, photographs, forensic reports, etc. Additionally, the Trumbull County Prosecutor's Office remains in possession and control of the Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM), which depicts, in horrifying and graphic detail, the rapes of then-toddler victim D.A., dob 12/21/2009 and 8-month old victim J.B., dob 8/18/2010. In an effort to prevent further victimization of these children, this office has chosen not to submit these videos to the Board at this time, However, these materials may be presented in their entirety, to the extent the rules permit, should this matter ever proceed to a full-board hearing or if the Board would request these videos for its full review of the evidence of her crime. This office believes it necessary for this Board to see the monstrosity and beast-like behavior of these sexual assaults and witness Felicia Beemer steal the innocence of two children in her care prior making a final determination on her release. Knowing the full evidence "beyond all doubt" provides wisdom and clarity in judgments in our opinion.

In closing, Ohio Administrative Code 5/20: 1-1-07- Procedure for release on parole... reads in relevant part:

- (a) An inmate may be released on or about the date of his eligibility for release, unless the parole board ... determines that he/she should not be released for one or more of the following reasons.

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- (1) There is substantial reason to believe that the inmate will engage in further criminal conduct, or that the inmate will not conform to such conditions of release.
- (2) There is substantial reason to believe that as the unique factors of the offense of conviction significantly outweigh the inmate's rehabilitative efforts...
- (3) There is substantial reason to believe that due to serious infractions... the release of the inmate would not act as a deterrent to the inmate or to other institutionalized inmates from violating institutional rules or regulations.

Let us summarize our view of the legal requirements of meeting the three (3) standards set out above to become as an inmate eligible and suitable for release on parole.

As for the First Requirement - No. 1 - there is absolute proof that Inmate Beemer continues to sexually victimize or assault others even while in prison – See PREDATORY ASSAULT OF JANUARY 27, 2025 and RAMPAGING HISTORY OF VIOLENCE, ASSAULTS, and THREATS (14 SEPARATE DOCUMENTED INCIDENTS, SEE pp 5- 5 Prosecutor's letters).

There is no reasonable support that Beemer as a Sexual Predator could be released on parole and not reoffend. She does not even go to rehabilitative classes- See latest reported infraction dated July 28, 2025- "Beemer was out of place today due to her unexcused absence from a mandatory class." Let's not even think about what she will do if she had access to children in society. One round of debauchery is enough for victims and society to suffer!

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As for the Second Requirement - No. 2 – Felicia Beemer has hit the jackpot on this one! In our humble opinion the “Unique Factors” found in her offenses of convictions (2) totally outweigh her non-existent efforts at rehabilitation. This woman along with her kind (or two of a kind) husband recorded the rapes of their own 8-month-old daughter and 18-month-old nephew – the videos shows Felicia Beemer giving each child oral. Furthermore, the records we are forwarding to you also show the inmate Beemer additionally was recorded engaging in oral sex acts with the family dog. It would be hard for us to believe that there are younger rape victims of other inmates in Ohio who had made recording their wicked defilement of the innocent including their own children. No matter how one looks at these crimes, inmate Beemer is one of the rarest of the demented sex offenders in prison today across this country. In this case, all three forensic experts agreed Beemer knew right from wrong.

As to the last Third Requirement - No. 3 - it is clear that the purpose of not releasing inmates who continuously commit serious infractions over years is that it would make a mockery of having rules of conduct and disciplinary action in prison to protect other inmates and administrative staff. With her bad behavioral record how could it be possible that she could be released on parole at the very first parole hearing on a 15 year to life sentence for raping an infant and toddler. In my world, it is not possible. At least that is our hope!

Therefore, this office sincerely requests that inmate Beemer’s parole be denied for the many reasons outlined in our letter to this Parole Board. This woman came to the plate under the terms of the Ohio Administrative Code as cited above, and struck out three times without even hitting the ball- she should never get to the plate of parole for ten years – and then let her whiff away for the rest of her life in the care of prison!

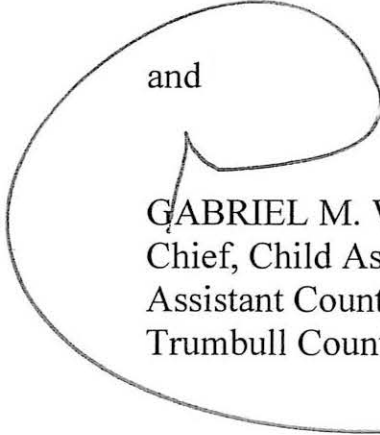

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Dear Members of the Parole Board,

In recognizing your time is incredibly valuable, I would only like a moment to convey my sincere request for your consideration to maintain present incarceration status for inmate #W85115 Felicia Beemer currently housed ROW.

My name is Roy Anne Malak, I am currently a twenty-year investigator with the Trumbull County Prosecutor's office. As such I am a partner with our Trumbull County Child Assault Prosecution Unit. Additionally, I have been a commissioned Ohio Peace officer for more than thirty years. In all my career in working with child sexual assault cases, I have observed few predators demonstrate such dedication and efforts to violate and molest children as that of Felicia Beemer. This individual not only lacks the common social grace to protect her own child, but she sexually assaulted her own child while inside the children's services facility. Furthermore, this monster memorialized this barbaric act on her phone to revisit later. Beemer had no regards or concerns for getting caught in a government building while sexually violating her own toddler,

We can also verify the molestation of at least one other known child family member. With this level of appalling depravity, I feel very strongly that this is most likely only the tip of the iceberg. With no hesitation or regard for being caught in the act, Beemer perpetrated these assaults with such confidence and comfort that one can only imagine the number of depraved attacks of other child victims that may have been exposed to her. Beemer shows no respect for society, authority, her own children, and most definitely herself.

The Institutional Report Summary for Beemer prepared by the Ohio department of Rehabilitation and Correction serves to support the obvious lack of desire to rehabilitate, effort to comply, and lack of remorse, while being encouraged to complete beneficial programs offered by the State of Ohio. Beemer reaffirms her inability and/or unwillingness to convert and prepare to become an appropriate member of society. And most importantly, Beemer's ability to control her egregious compulsions. I would ask the Ohio
