Dear Attorney Hoying:

This office has written to the parole board previously some eight (8) times strongly objecting to the above-captioned inmate's release on parole. Thankfully for 37 years (except for 7 months on parole) public safety has been insured with John Lysikowski remaining incarcerated in prison for his 1987 murder conviction and life sentence from Trumbull County. Retired Warren Municipal Court Judge and former Assistant Prosecutor Thomas Gysegem, who prosecuted this case and wrote the board that Lysikowski "represents a constant threat to the community." In my July 15, 2020 letter to the board, I wrote in relevant part: "He was released once over the past 33 years, and he nearly killed again. He truly is a career violent offender and sociopath. Any release of him would be a crime wave in the

making...his own prison behavior is the best evidence to prove how really dangerous he is to others...from what we have by way of DRC records of Lysikowski he may be Ripley's Believe It or Not discipline record holder for inmates from Trumbull County." (See attached letters from Prosecutor's Office).

Furthermore, I am including with this letter a copy of Lysikowski's Current Institutional Report Summary dated June 4, 2024. His Current Risk Score is 12 (low) and his Security Level is 2. However, his Program Participation rate is bad, for example, his Recovery Maintenance Program was terminated, he declined a Treatment Readiness Program, and a Thinking for a Change Program was recommended on July 15, 2016 and apparently, he is "still thinking about it." Most importantly, he is maintaining his discipline write-up record by having 15 more disciplinary proceedings for behavioral infractions since I last wrote the board on May 22, 2022, that is, more repeated violations over the last two-year period. Every year since 2006 he has committed rule violations involving bad conduct of every sort including acts of violence, drugs and stealing - clearly this man, at age 64, is not ready for prime time.

Furthermore, as the board is aware, inmate Lysikowski was paroled once back in 2007 and committed about a dozen violations of parole in just 5 months. One of his domestic violence victims wrote back then:

"On 09/08/07 he (Lysikowski) started the day abusing the animals, he bloodied the cat's mouth then took an ax after the dog. When I stopped him he threw the ax through a window at me and then came in and started beating on me. He punched me on the left side of my face and head. On 09/08/07 he came back at 4:30 a.m. he kicked in the door I called 911 when he kicked the door. He tried kicking me down the steps. He also stated one of us is dying tonight. And one of us are going back to prison. I am scared for my life."

Please review parole officers file records. Also, the parole board should have previously provided records from the Warren City Police Department

detailing the brutal stabbing death of Randy Nicholson, Warren, OH on June 20, 1987. As the board is further aware Mr. Nicholson was married and had a four-year old daughter at the time of his murder at the hands of inmate Lysikowski. Both the victim's wife and daughter suffered severe trauma because of his cold-blooded attack, including the daughter having "horrible nightmares." See victim Deborah Nicholson statement.

In closing, please do not release this inmate for the many reasons given in our letters and materials over many years. This is not a close call in our opinion! He was sentenced to life imprisonment by a judge for good cause and he has not made any good faith effort to change his ways!

I am enclosing copies of our most current Institutional Report Summary dated March 14, 2022. So since July 15, 2020 opposition to parole letter, this inmate has accumulated at least five (5) more Guilty Infractions in prison. For example, on November 1, 2021, he was found guilty of two (2) violations of the rules as summarized:

Be advised, while supervising serving lines for dinner service at 4:46 pm on 11.1.21, FSD Pabin requested inmate Lysikowski 199279 to scan his ID badge. The inmate immediately became argumentative stating he already scanned. I informed him that I could not recall seeing him and I again stated "Please scan your ID." Inmate Lysikowski still refused and began calling me a retard. For a third time I gave the directive for the inmate to scan his badge and the inmate Finally complied and continued with his inflammatory language called me retarded. Inmate Lysikowski has no reason speaking to a staff member in a derogatory fashion nor does he have any reason to argue over such a simple request. These are clear violations of rules 21 and 26 of the Inmate Rules of Conduct.

Though this is mild compared to his past behavioral record for years, it only exemplifies the fact this man has not changed and will likely continue his bad conduct outside prison walls. Since he has killed and injured others before and nothing has changed since we last wrote the parole board, we are providing the board our prior letters and stand by the position this office took in the July 15, 2020 letter opposing the parole of inmate Lysikowski.



From my count, Lysikowski has been written up 26 more times for behavioral infractions since I last wrote the board in 2016 (see attached prison records and copies of prior letters). Further, he has expanded his genre of bad activity from assaulting others, threatening inmates, and stealing to include suboxone drug abuse. On November 17, 2019, he was found to have tested positive for the drug Suboxone and received a 180-day restriction penalty (Suboxone is used to treat opiate addiction and is a narcotic). In short, there should be no need with this 60- year old man to go on and on with further proof when he never stops his criminal ways whether he is in prison or in society. Therefore, Lysikowski is a danger to others inside and outside of prison and as an incessant criminal and convicted killer (I join his victims in urging the Board) that he must be locked up for the rest of his natural life as the law allows and common sense demands.

After committing about a dozen violations while on parole in 2007 – one of his victims, Judy Rerko, said and I quote:

“On 09/08/07 he (Lysikowski) started the day abusing the animals, he bloodied the cat’s mouth then took an ax after the dog. When I stopped him he threw the ax through a window at me and then came in and started beating on me. He punched me on the left side of my face and head. On 09/08/07 he came back at 4:30 a.m. he kicked in the door. I called 911 when he kicked the door. He tried kicking me down the steps. He also stated one of us dying tonight. And one of us are going back to prison. I am scared for my life.”

Thereafter in 2007, he was returned to prison and from that time to 2013 (when he was once again considered for parole) he violated prison rules over forty times in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013. Well, just last week my office received in update on Lysikowski’s behavioral record for 2014, 2015 and 2016. It shows that inmate Lysikowski has not changed and like Ol’ Man River, he just keeps rolling along-assaulting and threatening other inmates and stealing among other infractions (see attached records). This man is a danger to others in and outside of prison, therefore, this incessant criminal must be locked up for the rest of his life as the law allows and the facts and common sense demands.

After writing my letter to you this date, I received in the mail a copy of Lysikowski's disciplinary record from the Southeastern Institution. Therefore, I am writing this letter as an addendum to my material with a brief comment.

By my calculations, this guy went back to prison in 2007 for violating his parole at least a dozen times in 5 months and upon returning to prison, he has managed to have violated prison rules in every year since his return over forty (40) times that is, he has a disciplinary record for 2013 (latest September 25, 2013), 2012, 2011, 2010, 2009 and 2008. Many of the dates on these violations have multiple charges (e.g. June 30, 2009 three violations to wit: [1] Giving false information or lying to department employees, [2] Misuse of authorized medication, and [3] Unauthorized possession, manufacture or consumption of drugs). These violations have occurred

He has killed two persons and is serving a life sentence. You released him once and he was a walking crime wave. He's a career violent criminal with an appetite to cause trouble. On January 26, 2012, December 29, 2009 and January 11, 2008, I wrote you letters opposing John Lysikowski release on parole for murder. Previously Assistant County Prosecutor Thomas P. Gysegem wrote the Board on October 26, 1987. Attorney Gysegem is presently Senior Municipal Court Judge for the City of Warren. He personally handled this case and stated that Lysikowski "represents a constant threat to the community."

From reviewing his criminal history and the circumstances surrounding his murderous act in Trumbull County and the recent events which occurred when he was released on parole in 2007, it is evident to me that this individual is a threat to society and will likely re-offend if released. Additionally, we are still waiting to hear from Department of Corrections with our RIB file records request regarding Lysikowski.

More importantly the prior documents we already sent you from the Youngstown Police Department dated 2007 and your own Adult Parole Authority

This office continues to object to his release for the reasons that are given in our prior letters which include written reports from two cases. It is our belief that this individual has a psychopathic personality and will remain a danger to the public.


Further, it is my opinion that once you granted parole to this convicted murderer on April 23, 2007, he demonstrated by his own words and conduct that he still is a continuing danger to society (remembering he killed twice previously with a knife) by managing to commit some 11 or 12 separate violations of parole in just five (5) months. His parole officials wrote: "Due to the offender's poor adjustment to supervision, continued criminal involvement and his flagrant use of alcohol and other drugs, Youngstown Unit I recommends that the offender's parole be revoked." It was revoked and Kudos for these officers for doing their jobs.
