Thankfully, the Board at that time, saw fit to not release him from prison and rescheduled once more his eligibility hearing for parole release consideration to 2026. After reviewing his most recent

institutional records dated July 8, 2026, which have not been redacted, it is apparent to me that this man's bad behavior has gotten worse since I last wrote you and clearly establishes and reaffirms that he is not suitable for release on parole now and that he would be a public safety risk to society.

On July 8, 2026, at our request, we received from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, a Current Institutional Report Summary on Ignacio Palma. A copy of this edited report is attached to this letter as is a copy of the unedited report dated November 7, 2016. We would note that Palma also has an Immigration and Customs Enforcement hold on him, placed on May 14, 2018 (there was a prior hold according to records). In my November 8, 2016 letter, I wrote the Board and suggested at the time that parole board members should read inmate Palma's infraction record from Southern Ohio Correctional facility, dated September 22, 2016, January 27, 2016, and March 12, 2014, which involved Palma's inappropriate behavior with a female staff member of prison and fist fighting with fellow inmates. Unfortunately, this man's bad behavior has gotten worse since 2016 and his security level has gone up from a 1 to a 2, which in my opinion, is still too low in light of what follows.

Guilty infractions after guilty infractions in 2026, 2025, and 2024 in prison underscore the continuing dangerousness of this man. It is unimaginable that this man should be released from prison to come back to Trumbull County, Ohio, or anywhere else in this country or planet earth. Humans everywhere are at risk! Let's just mention his latest two rules violations after more than 30 years in prison and numerous rehabilitation programs.

You mother fuckers. Don't let me out, I will kill that dude. I got life. Don't leave me here, I will kill the son of a bitch." Palma was taken out of RIB and back to O block. EOR (Emphasis added).

Second, just eight days before inmate Palma was written up again and found guilty again, this time:

On 4/21/2026 at approximately 12:00 p.m. I, Officer Peterson, conducted a shakedown of bed 43 in E Dorm. Upon searching a dictionary on the top bunk (housing Palma-300418) I did find six full strips of possible suboxone. EOR The Investigator's Office has determined that the substance is suboxone. J. Hecker.

It is interesting to note that unedited prison records that this office received in 2016 show how inmate Palma successfully completed course after course through the years in rehabilitation programs and interventions to make him a better a different person. Because recent records have been blacked out in these areas the Trumbull County Prosecutor's Office is unable, because of editing, to know how well he is doing in most of his recent Program Participation. However, two programs were unedited. We know that inmate Palma is on a Wait List for the Program Thinking for a Change (dated 10/28/21) and we also know he completed a Victim Awareness on March 26, 2025. Furthermore, in reviewing his Community Service Activity, he may, because of continuing education while in prison, be able to train dogs, plant flowers, do gardening, and know something about "CRAYONS TO COMPUTERS." Nevertheless, in reviewing his behavior history, Palma in my opinion, cannot escape his continuing record of being a con artist/sociopath when it comes to living with real people in the real world – his temper will always get in the way. Therefore, his punishment and its continuation was earned and there is a clear need to protect others from harm. That is not to say that numerous inmates that the parole board sees do not benefit from rehabilitative efforts and obviously don't have numerous rules violations – sadly Palma is not one of them!

As Ohio Statute states: “The overriding purposes of felony sentencing are to protect the public from future crime by the offender and others, to punish the offender, and to promote the effective rehabilitation of the offender ...” see Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.11(A). Inmate Palma fails on all levels! He was sentenced on November 10, 1994 for the murder with a firearm of his wife, Vivian Chancellor, age 42, and separate Felonious Assaults, and Incite Violence. In prior letters and attached police investigative reports to the Board by former Assistant Prosecutor, Diane Barber, including letters of September 18, 2007, January 23, 2012, and September 24, 2021, it is clear that Palma believed, because of reading some letters written to his wife, that there was another man in her life. Thereupon, his wife, who worked at the Trumbull Correction Institution, was called from work by Mr. Palma, who appeared at the prison saying that her grandchild was ill and she should come home. Several witnesses stated that earlier in that day, Mr. Palma made statements, while drinking, that he was going to kick the victim out. Instead, he shot her to death with a 12-gauge shotgun blast to the head. Please review Forensic Officer’s narrative regarding the horrific crime scene of the victim sitting in a chair when executed by this inmate. See Warren City Police Report attached.

As Prosecutor Barber stated – “This killing was a blatant act of plotting and scheming over a course of hours, by Palma, to kill Ms. Chancellor in cold blood.” It is also noted that Palma further displayed his uncontrollable anger and total disregard for human life when, while confined in the Trumbull County jail, along with a cellmate by the name of Alphonsia Perry (who also brutally murdered his domestic partner but in front of her two small children and is still serving his life sentence today) became enraged when they were told they had to move to another cell. Palma and Perry fought with three county deputies, threw chemicals in their faces and bruised their arms. Palma received concurrent terms of incarceration for these separate crimes along with the sentence of eighteen (18) years to life for the murder of Ms. Chancellor. Prosecutor Barber, in her 2007 letter, goes on to state: “Due to the fact that Mr. Palma has shown such propensity to violence and an inability to control his actions, this office, along with the surviving victims of Ms. Chancellor,

strongly believe that sixteen years does not serve ‘justice’ for either Ms. Chancellor or society. We strongly recommend that you keep Mr. Palma incarcerated for the entire sentence imposed by the Court.”

So whether it is our letters, including those of 2007, 2016, or today, the Trumbull County Prosecutor’s Office and the surviving victim’s family consistently and strongly maintain the view that inmate Palma should serve his full life sentence to ensure adequate punishment and protect the public from future crime. As the elected Prosecuting Attorney for Trumbull County with many years of experience handling thousands of cases involving violent crime and writing hundreds of letters to different parole boards for over forty years, I don’t believe I have ever witnessed a more fearless, daring, and highly creative approach to parole release by an inmate while being disciplined in prison than Palma. He is saying to corrections officials, parole me or I will kill a fellow inmate. He says he has nothing to lose if he kills in prison since he is serving a life sentence anyways. This jerk is in prison for murdering a defenseless woman – and has been rehabilitated beyond belief with programs – yet they have not been effective, which means in my mind, Ignacio Palma, after 36 years, IS NOT SUITABLE FOR RELEASE ON PAROLE AT THIS TIME OR EVER. Also, as an aside, Ohio’s policy and law, if rational, should be like it is now – IF you come to prison for murdering an innocent person and you murder a fellow prisoner, guard or anybody else, you don’t get to stay there to murder for a third time – you are executed if fair due process is provided to you even though your victims never got due process from you!

The purpose of this letter is to oppose parole for Ignacio A. Palma ("Palma"). Palma stands convicted of Murder with a firearm specification, in violation of O.R.C. 2903.02(A) and 2941.141; three (3) counts of Felonious Assault (F2), in violation of O.R.C. 2903.11(A)(1) and one (1) count Inciting to Violence (F3) in violation of O.R.C. 2917.01. The charges arose on May 4, 1994, when the Warren City Police Department received a call from Palma stating that he had just killed his wife. Officers went to the home Palma shared with Ms. Vivian Chancellor where they found Ms. Chancellor slumped over in a chair with a fatal bullet wound to the head. Palma made statements to the police that he had killed her because he had read letters to Chancellor from a man who wanted Chancellor to leave Palma. Ms. Chancellor, who worked at the Trumbull Correctional Institution, had been called home from work by Palma, who appeared at the prison saying that her grandchild was ill and that Chancellor needed to come home. Several witnesses stated that earlier in the day, Palma made statements, while drinking, that he was going to kick the victim out. One witness observed a shotgun sitting up against the wall and told Palma not to do anything stupid to which he replied that he wouldn't. The evidence showed that Palma plotted and schemed over a course of hours to kill Ms. Chancellor in cold blood.

To further showcase his uncontrollable anger and his total disregard for human life, Palma, while confined in the Trumbull County Jail, along with a cellmate by the

name of Alfonsia Perry (A300444), became enraged when they were told they had to move to another cell. Palma fought with the deputies, threw chemicals in their faces and bruised their arms. He and Perry incited each other to continue fighting and eventually had to be shackled and put in isolation. Palma was sentenced to concurrent terms of incarceration for these crimes together with the sentence of eighteen (18) years to life for the murder of Ms. Chancellor. Due to the fact that Palma has shown such a propensity to violence and an inability to control his actions, this office strongly believes that twenty-seven (27) years does not serve justice for either Ms. Chancellor or society. We continue to strongly recommend that you keep Palma incarcerated for the entire sentence imposed by the Court.

Previously this office has written the parole board opposing the release on parole of inmate Palma. See letters of Assistant Prosecutor Diane L. Barber dated January 23, 2012 and September 18, 2007. I am also enclosing with these letters relevant materials surrounding the shotgun shooting death of his wife who was an employee of the Trumbull Correctional Institution at the time of her death. The facts in our opinion show a premeditated plan to kill his wife including a pretext call to her at work claiming an illness to a grandchild to get her to leave early from her job.

As Ms. Barber stated in her 2012 letter, which we now repeat (because of the circumstances of the crime and Palma's explosive tendency along with recent infractions in prison) ... "We continue to strongly recommend that you keep Palma

The witness observed a shotgun sitting up against the wall and told Palma not to do anything stupid to which he replied that he wouldn't. The evidence showed that Palma plotted and schemed over a course of hours to kill Ms. Chancellor in cold blood.

To further showcase his uncontrollable anger and his total disregard for human life, Palma, while confined in the Trumbull County Jail, along with a cellmate by the name of Alfonsia Perry (A300444), became enraged when they were told they had to move to another cell. Palma fought with the deputies, threw chemicals in their faces and bruised their arms. He and Perry incited each other to continue fighting and eventually had to be shackled and put in isolation. Palma was sentenced to concurrent terms of incarceration for these crimes together with the sentence of eighteen (18) years to life for the murder of Ms. Chancellor. Due to the fact that Palma has shown such a propensity to violence and an inability to control his actions,

this office strongly believes that seventeen (17) years does not serve justice for either Ms. Chancellor or society. We continue to strongly recommend that you keep Palma incarcerated for the entire sentence imposed by the Court.

On May 4, 1994, the Warren City Police Department received a call from Ignatio Palma stating that he had just killed his wife. Police officers went to the home of Mr. Palma and Ms. Vivian Chancellor and found Ms. Chancellor slumped over in a chair with a fatal bullet wound to the head. Mr. Palma made statements to the police that he had killed her because he had read letters from someone who wanted her to leave Palma and go with him. Ms. Chancellor, who worked at the Trumbull Correctional Institution, was called home from work by Mr. Palma, who appeared at the prison saying that her grandchild was ill and she should come home. Several witnesses stated that earlier in that day, Mr. Palma made statements, while drinking, that he was going to kick the victim out. The witness observed a shotgun sitting up against the wall, and told Palma not to do anything stupid to which he replied he wouldn't. This killing was a blatant act of plotting and scheming over a course of hours, by Palma, to kill Ms. Chancellor in cold blood.

To further show his display of uncontrollable anger and total disregard for human life, Palma, while confined in the Trumbull County Jail, along with a cellmate by the name of Alphonsia Perry, became enraged when they were told they had to move to another cell. Palma fought with the deputies, threw chemicals in their faces and bruised their arms. He and Perry incited each other to continue fighting and eventually had to be shackled and put in isolation. Palma received concurrent terms of incarceration for these crimes along with the sentence of eighteen (18) years to life for the

murder. Due to the fact that Mr. Palma has shown such propensity to violence and an inability to control his actions, this office, along with the surviving victims of Ms. Chancellor, strongly believe that sixteen years does not serve "justice" for either Ms. Chancellor or society. We strongly recommend that you keep Mr. Palma incarcerated for the entire sentence imposed by the Court.
