Dear Attorney Hoying:

I last wrote to the parole board on August 12, 2019, opposing the release of inmate Petersime on parole. Previously, I had written to you on October 6, 2014, October 8, 2014, and December 16, 2009. I am today sending you copies of all our letters and material since you have new members on the board for your review. My office, including our Child Assault Division and Victim/Witness Division,

believes any release into society of inmate Petersime would create an undue risk to public safety, especially to male children. Mr. Petersime was clinically diagnosed as a pedophile in a Sexual Predator evaluation for a Trumbull County judge dated October 26, 1999 (see nine-page report included). Also included with this letter is the three page Finding of Facts and Conclusions of Law of Judge W. Wyatt McKay dated November 2, 1999, classifying Martin Petersime as a Sexual Predator as set for in Section 2950.09 of the Ohio Revised Code. The bottom line is that the court found at a hearing that "...there is clear and convincing evidence ... that (Petersime) ... is likely to engage in the future on one or more sexually oriented offenses ..." One expert put it this way "...Mr. Petersime poses a high risk to the community and may be likely to engage in the future in a sexually oriented offense against a child." Even Petersime, in an interview with a forensic psychologist, stated he was a "sexual addict" and "openly and readily admits to his sexual attraction to young males..."

As the board is aware, there are more than six child victims just from Trumbull County and he has twenty felony convictions against children from our county. Additionally, there are other known victims. Furthermore, he had been previously convicted in other areas of Ohio for sex offenses involving children. From the Petersime criminal history, he has been the "traveling pedophile" going from Piqua, Ohio to Cleveland and to Warren practicing his trade. Thankfully, inmate Petersime was denied parole by the parole board in 2019 (his last release hearing) even though he had not committed any known rule infractions for 9 years and the Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections put his Current risk Score low at 5 (which we strongly disagree with because there are no children in prison!).

Now that the parole board has scheduled inmate Petersime for another release hearing in July and possible parole, this office again obtained updated Current Institutional Report Summary which shows as of June 4, 2024, this inmate's Current Risk Score and Security Level has not changed. So, it is our earnest hope that this new board will see, like the previous board, that the current status for Petersime

should not change. He's been safe and we have been safe with him serving 31 years there. And with Petersime continuing to serve the remainder of his 40-year sentence you will be guaranteeing that no child will be harmed by him. Please read our letters and material because there are so many good reasons for keeping this man locked up as long as possible! Afterall, this is a person who after serving 20 years behind bars, was caught in prison by corrections officials downloading pornography and at another time committing sex acts on inmates in prison (see updated Institutional Report dated June 4, 2024).

This man's profile shows him repeatedly using extreme and planned schemes to stalk, groom, and use child victims, without any regard to their safety, well-being and future. His history of self-destructive conduct, immoral behavior, and hypocritical pretension as a music teacher is beyond belief. In our opinion, this man is lying in wait to get out of prison and then finding his next child victim.

Your Administrative Rule: Rule 5120:1-1-07 Procedure for Release on Parole... effective July 29, 2021...states:

(A) An inmate may be released on or about the date of his eligibility for release, unless the parole board ... determines that he should not be released on such date for one or more of the following reasons:

...

(2) There is a substantial reason to believe that as the unique factors of the offense of conviction significantly outweigh the inmates rehabilitative efforts, the release of the inmate into society would create undue risk to public safety and/or would not further the interests of justice nor be consistent with the welfare and security of society (emphasis added); (Please read the victims statements and all the surrounding circumstances involved with Petersime's twenty (20) convictions of sex offenses against six (6) different children including Martin Petersime offering to a boy \$15.00 to make a porn movie which was done and which included 39 year-old Petersime (music store owner

and teacher) filming himself as instruction to the child as to how to dance to the music of Van Halen's song "Running with the Devil" should be performed while nude and at the same time committing a sex act. Truly we believe there are over the top unique factors in Petersime's offenses and conduct which appropriately justify his continued incarceration for public safety.

Moreover, one must just marvel over Petersime's inability to change his ways or feel some shame and responsibility for what he has done to himself, family, friends, and community as a leader. After many years in prison, what has he learned and how has he improved himself with the many rehabilitative efforts by correction officials and others to guide and better himself. Please take a look at Rule 5120: 1-1-07(B)(3) reads and undermines any release:

(3) The inmate's ability to control the inmate's behavior, and the degree to which the inmate demonstrates impulsivity in prison or in the community. In evaluating an inmate's ability to control the inmate's behavior, the board will consider:

- (a) any reports of physical, mental or psychiatric examination of the inmate.
- (b) any reports prepared by any department of rehabilitation and correction staff member relating to an inmate's personality and social history.

(Please read 1992 and 1999 reports including forensic examinations concerning his history and continuation of bad behavior and demonstrated impulsivity while outside and inside prison as found in Infraction Summary of Richland Correctional Institution dated November 4, 2011, and June 23, 2011. This man's personality disorder is, in our opinion, a lifetime condition with the inmate and that is why the evidence, law, good judgement and discretion should require his continued incarceration. He cannot control himself and being seventy (70) years old does not mean he is less dangerous to children once released from prison.

Dear Ms. Thalheimer:

Please be advised that since there are several new parole board members serving now than when I last wrote the board in 2014, I am including with this letter in opposition to inmate Petersime's release on parole, a copy of my prior materials including my letters of December 16, 2009, October 6, 2014 and October 8, 2014. Without a doubt to know Martin Petersime is to know the consummate child sexual

predator lurking among us. Thankfully the parole board with its past decisions regarding Petersime has kept us safe and more specifically, our children out of harm's way.

This man has done it all and more. Please review my letters and e-mail letter attached to my October 8, 2014 letter from a non-reported child molestation victim of Petersime which I received in November, 2011. It is quite chilling. Sadly, there are many more out there like him suffering because of Petersime's skill and cunningness in molesting the young and duping adults (Further, several victims have through the years to present, been involved in both local and state programs opposing Petersime's release). Fortunately on April 28, 1992, one brave boy saved many others from becoming victims by turning over to police a video tape of Petersime unplugged dancing nude to the music of Van Halen. (See December 16, 2009 letter to the board).

Unfortunately, though predictably, this man's aberrant behavior inside of prison over the years clearly shows that he is wired differently and does not learn from his past mistakes. He has no shame. He does not know the definition of rehabilitation. Please look at Inmate Petersime's Institutional records attached, dated November 4, 2011 at Richland Correctional Institution, where he was found guilty of two rules infractions (Rules 49 and 59). These R.I.B. offenses are defined: Rule 49 - "Destruction, alteration, or misuse of property" and Rule 59 - "Any act not otherwise set forth herein, knowingly done which constitutes a threat to the security of the institution, its staff, other inmates, or to the acting inmate" (emphasis added).

A summary of the facts reported against Petersime in 2011 show that he was involved in an Ashland University Outreach program at Richland Correctional as a tutor for others when Ashland University lab technicians discovered pornography on a computer which only Petersime had the password to the computer. "According to all techs, Inmate Petersime (Martin) became very upset, yelling at them stating that they were messing up the lab, that since they started working on the computers nothing was working right anymore (the AU techs felt threatened by Inmate Petersime due to his behavior)." (emphasis added) The incident report did not say

whether the computer had child pornography, which is a crime. And he is in prison for several crimes related to disseminating pornography to children.

Further, this is the same guy who had just been disciplined some five (5) months prior by prison officials for being found by corrections officers during a routine building check performing oral sex on an inmate. To add insult to injury, Inmate Petersime, a few years earlier completed at taxpayer expense, Victim Awareness; Mandatory Sex Offender Program; and a Victim Empathy Program (one just wonders how he thought about his past victims when he was watching pornography in prison in 2011). Also, according to prison records, Petersime who went to prison in 1992, has yet to complete a comprehensive sex offender program. Really! This inmate's consistent behavior and thinking over many years makes him one incorrigible creepy crawler!

Petersime (age 65), a court determined sexual predator (see attached November 2, 100 entry of Judge W Wyatt McKay), has approximately 13 years more to serve out his maximum sentence (04/19/2032). If he serves out the maximum, he will be nearly 80 years old and less likely to reoffend, though there still will be some risk to the community (see attached newspaper article regarding "Grandpa" Sypnier in Western New York who was molesting children into his 90's). Here in Trumbull County we have successfully prosecuted pedophiles in their 60's, 70's and even one predator was sentenced to life at age 80 for raping a 9 year-old relative. Sometimes evil-doing doesn't end until death!

It is worth mentioning that pedophiles, like Petersime, who has lifetime character flaws which result in repeated victimization of children have been subject to special laws to protect the public. In fact, in the United State today, 17 states have sex offender civil commitment statutes to protect children and adults from people who have served their maximum prison sentence but are still dangerous. Ohio back in 2009 considered then Senate Bill 67 to provide civil commitment of sex offenders and instituting a multidisciplinary team established by the DRC to determine whether a person qualifies as a sexual predator. Unfortunately, the bill did not pass

and become law. Looking ahead, Ohio needs to reconsider its position on civil commitment to better protect the children and adults of Ohio from sexual predators.

In closing, as the parole board knows from the Petersime criminal history, Petersime has been the "Traveling Pedophile" going from Piqua, Ohio to Cleveland, Ohio and to Warren, Ohio. Because he has an insatiable sexual appetite for children, Petersime, at age 65, would be especially deceptively dangerous to them if released on parole. He needs to stay in prison until April 18, 2032! Furthermore, by keeping him in prison, Petersime will be unable to earn a possible new moniker "Grandpa Pedophile". Please keep the kids SAFE!!

On December 16, 2009 I wrote the Board a letter regarding the possible release on parole of Martin A. Petersime for his 20 separate felony sex offenses against children committed in Trumbull County. Various materials were included in that letter for your review. Petersime was denied parole in 2009 and his case was continued for 5 years. This office has again received notice that another hearing is scheduled before the Parole Board during the month of November, 2014 to consider his release.

As the Board is aware, Trumbull County Common Pleas Judge W. Wyatt McKay in 1992, sentenced the Defendant to 12 to 40 years in prison. He has served 21 years and 9 months of the maximum 40 year sentence. I am enclosing with this letter, a copy of the same materials as given to you in 2009 for your

reconsideration. The overwhelming evidence of guilt in this matter, his utter failure to uphold any semblance of trust or moral values to the parents and community he held out to as a leader and teacher, and his long history of pedophilic behavior with many different children only underscore the absolute need to keep Petersime in prison.

The enormity of these crimes also requires the longest possible imprisonment and the pure danger to the community involved with any release demands, in our opinion, a continuation of imprisonment. With 18 plus more years in prison, the Parole Board will be guaranteeing the safety of our children. This pedophile surely will not change his stripes once out on the streets whether it is in Piqua, Ohio, Cleveland or Warren (where he committed his past offenses) or some other place as history has shown, once released, Martin Petersime in the highest likelihood will be trolling for kids to molest. Therefore, this office as in 2009, strongly recommends that Petersime serve his full sentence to the year 2032 when he will be nearly 80 years old.

FINDING OF FACT AND
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This cause came on to be heard before the Honorable Judge W. Wyatt McKay on October 29, 1999, with respect to whether the Defendant, Martin Petersime, should be classified as a Sexual Predator under Ohio Revised Code Section 2950.09.

Defendant had previously filed a Motion to Dismiss. That motion is hereby denied.

Attorney Anthony Consoldane appeared in behalf of the Defendant, Martin Petersime, who waived his presence for this hearing. Thomas C. Wrenn, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, appeared in behalf of the State. Gerald L. Heinbaugh of the Forensic Psychiatric Center of Northeast Ohio performed a Sexual Predator evaluation for the State of Ohio and Keith J. Smedi, Ph.D., performed an evaluation for the Defendant.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) The Court received into evidence State's Exhibit #1, Mr. Heinbaugh's report.
- (2) Both parties stipulated to the factual accuracy of the background information contained in that report.
- (3) Defense Counsel indicated to the Court that Dr. Smedi's evaluation produced essentially the same results as Mr. Heinbaugh's report.
- (4) Mr. Heinbaugh (a) interviewed the Defendant, (b) reviewed prison records, (c)

administered instruments, and (d) addressed the criteria established by statute for "Sexual Predator classification".

- (5) Mr. Heinbaugh's diagnostic impression of the Defendant was "Pedophilia, Same Sex, Non-exclusive". He did not find any indication of a mood or thought disorder.
- (6) Mr. Petersime pled guilty to a 20 count indictment.
- (7) Mr. Petersime has two prior convictions in 1975, one in Piqua, Ohio, for contributing to the delinquency of a minor, and the other in Cleveland, Ohio, for exhibiting materials harmful to a juvenile.
- (8) Mr. Petersime admitted to Mr. Heinbaugh that he is sexually attracted to young males and teenage males.
- (9) In the present case, there were five (5) male victims under age 18.
- (10) Mr. Petersime indicated to Mr. Heinbaugh that "he kept marijuana on hand to entice teenage boys to participate in sexual activities with him".
- (11) Although Mr. Petersime has completed several levels of the institution's sex offender treatment program, Mr. Heinbaugh indicated that he still minimizes his lengthy history of sexually aggressive behavior.
- (12) Mr. Heinbaugh reported that "the nature and pattern of Mr. Petersime's behavior at the time of the offense appeared to be similar to many pedophiles. Mr. Petersime's risk to re-offend increases due to the fact that his child victims were males, they were outside of his family and he expresses a specific sexual interest in male children".
- (13) Mr. Heinbaugh concluded "that Mr. Petersime poses a high risk to the community and may be likely to engage in the future in a sexually oriented offense against a child".

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Based on the report of the examination performed on the Defendant by Mr. Heinbaugh for the State of Ohio and unopposed by the Defendant, the Court finds that there is clear and convincing evidence that the Defendant has been convicted of a sexually oriented crime and is likely to engage in the future in one or more sexually oriented offenses, and therefore, is a Sexual Predator as set forth in Section 2950.09 of the Ohio Revised Code.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Defendant, MARTIN PETERSIME, is hereby classified as a Sexual Predator as set forth in Section 2950.09 of the Ohio Revised Code.

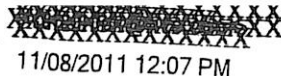

Now I am 48 years old and an executive at a ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ company, with ~~XXX~~ kids of my own. We're in the process of relocating ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~, where I am now. My wife and kids are still back in ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ until the house sells.

...regretfully, would you recommend I go ahead and write to the parole board in anticipation of future parole applications? Since I never pursued this matter with the courts, does such an account or opinion even bear hearing by a parole board? Do they care about, or put stock in such things?

My apologies for the long e-mail...I just feel like there's something I should do. Any guidance you can provide would be greatly appreciated.

May God bless you and your office for your relentless defense of innocent victims,

On April 28, 1992, a savvy 15 year old boy became an instant hero in Trumbull County when he chose to take drastic action in spite of danger to himself to expose a child molester and predator who had successfully duped many in our community that he was a good person and leader. The uncovering came when Martin Petersime, age 39, of the Warren Music Store on that fateful day, requested the 15 year old boy, who he had met a few days before at the store, to stay after hours to watch porno movies downstairs in what he called Rm. B. He asked the boy if he wanted to make a porn movie for \$15.00. According to the boy, Petersime said all he "had to do was dance in front of a camera and act like a strip tease and throw my whip around." "He had me take all my clothes off and lay on the floor with my leg propped up jacking off." Petersime then asked the boy to film him. The boy continued: "While I filmed him Petersime took his clothes off and was jacking off (masturbating) on camera" while dancing to the music of Van Halen's song "Running With the Devil."

Afterwards, Petersime went upstairs to get some vasoline when the boy "grabbed as much of [his] clothes as [he] could and took the tape out of the camera" and ran out of the store with the tape with Petersime chasing the boy in the nude. Thankfully, the boy escaped and ran to the Warren Police station which was nearby (to this day-I wonder what would have happened to the boy if Petersime would have caught him!) With this letter, I am providing the Board three (3) DVD copies of Petersime's Dancing to the Music in its original unedited version.

As a result of this evidence and further evidence obtained by the Warren Police Department through its investigation and search warrants, the State was able to indict Petersime on twenty (20) separate felony counts involving six (6) different children (see attached materials). I would also note that as a result of the investigation, other children came forward and reported also being abused by Petersime years before while music students at the store. Without needing to go into detail, there obviously has been great psychological injury and damage done by this man to many children.

The proof was so great that the Defendant pled guilty to all twenty (20) counts of the indictment including two (2) rape counts involving eleven and twelve year old boys and was sentenced by Trumbull County Common Pleas Judge W. Wyatt McKay to an indeterminate sentence of 12 to 40 years in prison. The agreed plea and sentence avoided a public trial for these children and respected their privacy through a difficult time.

It is noted that prior to his December 1, 1992 sentencing on twenty (20) felony charges, Martin Petersime was convicted in 1975 in Piqua, Ohio for contributing to the delinquency of a minor. He said he would frequently "drive down the freeway and hold up dirty pictures" to children. In 1976, Petersime, after moving, pled guilty in Cuyahoga County to two (2) counts of exhibiting materials harmful to a juvenile while in his car and received one-year probation.

In October 1999, Petersime was subject to a court ordered sexual predator evaluation (see included Report of Forensic Psychiatric Center of Northeast, Ohio,

Inc. dated October 26, 1999). Though forensic experts state that the Defendant does not suffer from mental illness or a personality disorder, he is a pedophile. According to these experts "...Mr. Petersime poses a high risk to the community and may be likely to engage in the future in a sexually oriented offense against a child." Obviously, Petersime is very smart and manipulative with a voracious appetite for sex with children (he graduated Magna Cum Laude from Wittenberg University and had completed all his graduate studies except his thesis at Youngstown State University Dana School of Music).

According to Trumbull County Prosecutor's Office Victim Advocate Miriam Fife, there are two (2) active victims in our victim program in this case. There have been as many as five (5) victims in the program over the years. It is our hope that these victims will be spared having to testify before a full board hearing in this matter. Also I would add that this office would have much more "telling evidence" about Petersime if a hearing were required.

In conclusion, Martin Petersime has admitted to giving drugs to children to facilitate sex with them, having group sex with kids, producing pornographic films with children and himself, and participating in the following deviant sexual behaviors: frottage, voyeurism, obscene phone calling, pedophilia, use of prostitutes, sexual affairs, sex with strangers, and the use of pornography. Forensic experts state that to all the deviant sexual behaviors Petersime reported, he said that "he is in nearly complete control or absolute control." (emphasis added). Well, the State now has complete control over him while he remains in prison. He truly is the Pervert's Pervert. Under my calculation, he has 23 more years to serve to fulfill the 40 year sentence he certainly has earned and deserved. Therefore, this office strongly recommends that Martin Petersime serve his full sentence to the year 2032. He will be nearly eighty (80) years old.

grandfather told his hometown newspaper, The Buffalo News.

A former daughter-in-law said he is not likely to get the chance.

"No one from the family plans to have any contact with him," Diane Sypnier said before ending a brief phone interview.

Being grandfatherly was how the 5-foot-5, 150-pound Sypnier found his victims, authorities say. After his most recent arrest at age 90 on charges of raping and sodomizing a 4-year-old girl and her 7-year-old sister, his neighbors in the suburb of Tonawanda recalled what appeared to be a kindly Sypnier offering rides to adults, handing out money to children so they could buy candy, and baby-sitting.

The victimized sisters called him "Grandpa," their mother said at the time, adding that it "was a total shock" when police showed her sexually explicit pictures of her girls found in Sypnier's apartment.

Sypnier's convictions date to 1987, when he was given three years' probation for sex abuse. He spent a year in prison for sexually abusing a minor in 1994.

His neighbors in Tonawanda never knew of Sypnier's background because he was convicted before the adoption of laws requiring sex offenders to register with police.

A relative once came forward and said Sypnier had molested her while she was growing up, former Erie County prosecutor Frank Clark told the News. Authorities wonder what else might lie in Sypnier's past.


"People don't start to become pedophiles at 78," Erie County District Attorney Frank Sedita told the AP. "I call them vampires. ... This is something that's deep inside of them, and they won't want to stop doing this until they're dead."

Aging: still the same at the century mark

The intricate Christmas carvings that emerge from the Leominster workshop of 99-year-old Louis Charpentier are a reflection of his essential character, undimmed over 10 decades.

About 400 miles away, 100-year-old Theodore Sypnier is preparing for a new life of freedom after a decade of incarceration as New York's oldest registered sex offender. And while some people might be tempted to view Sypnier's age as mitigation - or perhaps even as a sign that the strictures of sex-offender registration extend too far - those most familiar with his crimes have no illusions. The last time he was free, at 90, Sypnier used his grandfatherly appearance to win the trust of a 4-year-old girl and her 7-year-old sister, raping both of them. Now, one must assume that Sypnier's essential nature, like Charpentier's, hasn't changed.

Advanced age has never been a curative, but some in society tend to be so awed by the prospect of longevity that they assume virtue must go along with it. Others are just naturally protective of the most senior of citizens, like a nation of Willard Scotts gazing fondly at a gallery of twinkling oldsters.

Despite all that, it should be heartening to know that people can be fully themselves as they approach their second century, but that realization should also be a warning. So celebrate Louis "Mr. Christmas" Charpentier. Be wary of Theodore Sypnier. And remember that 100 is just another chapter of life. ■
