Since fifty-nine year old inmate William Judson was sent to prison over 30 years ago this office has written the Parole Board some nine times strongly opposing his release on parole and on October 21, 2020, Assistant Prosecutor, Diane Barber, Chief of my Child Assault attended a virtual Full Board Hearing with one of his victims and continued our objections to his release on parole. (It is noted that previously, in 2009, the Ohio Parole Board had granted Judson parole and he violated the terms of his parole and was returned to prison). Despite our objections and his prior failure on parole, the parole board granted, once again, Judson's release on parole on December 21, 2020 with five years of parole supervision. See attached News Release by Trumbull County Prosecuting Attorney dated November 9, 2020.

Unfortunately, this convicted child rapist would again violate parole as learned by then Administrator of our Victim/Witness Division, Mary Jo Hoso, when he was arrested in Akron, Ohio on November 9, 2021 and then taken to Lorain Correctional on November 10, 2021 and subsequently, at a hearing, was found to be a parole violator. Ms. Hoso spoke directly with a parole officer in 2022 and was informed that Judson's violation was "some form of contact with minors" but he would not give her the specifics of the violation due to ODRC Privacy Policy. See attached memo of Mary Jo Hoso dated March 31, 2022. However, subsequently DRC provided this office further information with a copy of its Revocation Order, including the names of children involved and other drug charges against Judson. Please consider this letter as a request by this office for copies of additional information and witness statements regarding Judson's violation of parole in 2021, in the event there may yet be another board decision to grant Judson another parole which we would certainly demand another Full Board Hearing to present available information and new evidence to justify our position.

As Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.11 states in relevant part: "The overriding purpose of felony sentencing are to protect the public from future crimes by the offender and others, to punish the offender, and to promote effective rehabilitation of the offender..." Well, from our perspective, the evidence and history of William Judson's sexual predatory bad conduct involving children as young as 5 years old and other criminal behavior has become so chronic, unpredictable, and dangerous to children and the public that it seems it should defy logic and common sense to release him again on parole before he serves his maximum sentence of 50 years. THIS GUY TRULY DESERVES TO STAY THERE! As we said previously, Judson has shown repeatedly by his past actions that he is truly an ambidextrous criminal who engages in a rainbow of different types of anti-social activity and, therefore, should not be left to roam the streets.

In conclusion, please consider reading our July 25, 2016 letter to the Board (along with the letter of September 17, 2020), especially review Parole officials, Jeffery Erwin and Robert O'Malley's Violation Hearing Report of June 28, 2011 and our "17 REASONS WHY" Judson should serve the maximum sentence provided by law. However, because Judson's reoffending is a product of his antisocial personality disorder and his targets often are children, prison is the only answer. That is why we add his latest bout of bad behavior outside of prison walls on November 18, 2021 and his latest inside prison walls violations dated November 7, 2024, August 4, 2024, and April 11, 2024 (total of five separate Guilty Infractions) (See attached Current Institutional Report Summary dated October 9, 2025) as the "18th REASON WHY" inmate Judson should serve his maximum term to 2042. Though he may able to get to his bunk area of his cell "a large folder full of pornographic material" again by being in prison—you can guarantee for many years that he won't get his pedophile hands on a child or otherwise wreak societal havoc by staying in prison and serving his maximum sentence.

OHIO PAROLE BOARD GRANTED PAROLE TO WILLIAM JUDSON

On Wednesday, October 21, 2020, members of the Trumbull County Prosecutor's office attended a virtual Full Board Hearing conducted by the Ohio Parole Board, on convicted rapist William Judson. Attorney Diane Barber, Chief of the Child Assault Unit, presented the State's case opposing parole. Twenty-eight years ago, the Trumbull County Child Assault Prosecution Unit prosecuted Judson for sex offenses he perpetrated against a child victim. He was convicted of two counts of Rape, aggravated felonies of the first degree. The victim was nine years old at the time of the indicted offenses, but evidence showed that Judson had been molesting the victim and another relative for years prior to that. He was sentenced to fifteen to fifty years in prison.

Previously, in 2009, the Ohio Parole Board granted Judson parole. After violating the terms of his parole, he was returned to prison in 2011. This office has strongly opposed Judson's release with written letters each time he has come up for parole. Despite that, earlier this year, Judson was scheduled for release. Upon hearing of Judson's imminent release, Prosecutor Watkins directed that Victim/Witness Advocate Mary Jo Hoso and Investigator Roy Anne Rudolph to contact the victim, who requested a full board hearing. Thereafter, the parole board cancelled Judson's release and the matter was scheduled for a full board hearing.

Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Diane Barber and Mary Jo Hoso, Victim/Witness Advocate, attended the virtual hearing with Judson's victim. Attorney Barber and the victim argued against Judson's release.

Despite our opposition, the parole board granted Judson parole. He will be released on or after December 21, 2020 with five years of supervision (parole) including the following conditions: release to a halfway house or other housing, placement to be approved by the Parole Board; no unsupervised contact with minor children; and the supervising adult to be approved

by the parole authority. See copy of Ohio Parole Board Decision and Minutes, attached. Further, pursuant to court order, Judson will be required to register as a sexually oriented offender.

The case was jointly investigated in 1991 by the Champion Police Department and investigators with both Trumbull County Children's Services and the Trumbull County Prosecutor's Office.

In closing, it is important to mention that the Trumbull County Prosecutor's Office has worked closely with the Ohio Parole Board and Office of Victim Services for many years and respects their difficult work and decisions, always recognizing that reasonable persons sometimes disagree with the outcome.

William Judson was arrested in Akron on November 9, 2021 and was taken to Lorain Correctional on November 10, 2021. A Parole Violation Hearing was held on January 1, 2022. The result of the hearing was that William Judson will not be eligible for release until January, 2026. The Review Hearing will be held in November of 2025.
