

# Trumbull County grand jury indicts 37

A Trumbull County grand jury on Thursday, April 3, 2025, returned 37 indictments including one secret or sealed case.

The grand jurors also made a visit to the Trumbull County jail to examine its condition and inquire into the discipline and treatment of the prisoners. In its report, the jurors noted the jail was in excellent condition and the tour was given in a very professional manner.
